

**CURASCRIPT, INC.**  
**DISCLOSURE STATEMENT**

As a provider of specialty pharmacy and infusion pharmacy services, CuraScript, Inc. and its wholly-owned or affiliated pharmacies (collectively, referred to as “CuraScript”) typically provide a wide array of pharmacy services. This Disclosure Statement applies collectively to all pharmacies affiliated with CuraScript, Inc.

When third party payers engage CuraScript to provide pharmacy services, depending on the particular disease state, these services provided to patients may include, but are not limited to:

- a) Patient Intake Services: patient enrollment, initial referral processing, insurance eligibility and benefits verification, alternative coverage searches, schedule of initial medication order, and coordination of patient education and instruction for each new patient;
- b) Pharmacy Dispensing Services: dispensing of the medications pursuant to a prescription in accordance with applicable law, the deposit of such medications with a third party carrier (e.g., Federal Express) to facilitate the delivery of same as per the patient’s instructions, and the provision of certain ancillary supplies (e.g., syringes, needles, and alcohol swabs) and related items in connection with the medication that may be necessary or useful to the patient in connection with the administration of the medication;
- c) Ongoing Clinical and Specialty Pharmacy Support Services: self-injection teaching support, patient education, assessment, clinical interventions and clinical screenings, therapy adherence counseling and related clinical patient management activities and programs (e.g., CuraScript’s CareLogic® programs), physician consultations, authorization maintenance, partial prior authorization (upon request by client and upon signing necessary forms), assistance with patient coverage appeals, re-fill follow-up calls, managing ongoing medication orders, and insurance follow-up and related ongoing delivery coordination; and
- d) Social Services: patient advocacy, hardship reimbursement support, and indigent and patient assistance programs.

If CuraScript’s clients desire additional information regarding these services in addition to the information that already has been provided, CuraScript will provide client with the additional information upon request.

CuraScript complies with all applicable laws, including applicable patient privacy laws. CuraScript retains the right to use and disclose patient information in connection with conducting its business, including such lawful uses and/or disclosures in which CuraScript obtains compensation from third parties, provided CuraScript’s activities comply with applicable law, including the applicable patient privacy laws.

CuraScript purchases its prescription drug inventories either directly from manufacturers or from drug wholesalers for dispensing to patients or for distribution to physician offices. Purchase or related discounts off the acquisition cost of these products are often made available by manufacturers in the form of both up-front and retrospective discounts. When CuraScript dispenses or distributes a product from its inventory, the purchase price paid for the dispensed product, including applicable dispensing fees if any, may be greater or less than the pharmacy’s acquisition cost for the product, net of applicable purchase or other discounts from the manufacturer. In general, CuraScript realizes an overall positive margin between this net

acquisition cost and the amounts paid for the dispensed products. In addition, CuraScript may receive compensation from manufacturers or other third parties related to the provision of certain programs, data reporting, or pharmacy services. Furthermore, often as a condition to receiving access to certain products, a pharmaceutical manufacturer will require a purchasing pharmacy to report selected HIPAA-compliant information to the manufacturer or its designee regarding the pharmacy's service levels and other dispensing-related data for patients who receive such manufacturer's product, all of which are in compliance with HIPAA. A portion of the discounts or other compensation made available to CuraScript often represents compensation for such reporting. All such discounts and other compensation described above are negotiated on CuraScript's own behalf and CuraScript retains all proprietary rights to such discounts and fees. CuraScript represents and warrants that its pharmacy services are clinically objective. CuraScript does not recommend or engage in activities to promote therapeutic substitutions (i.e., recommendations to consider the use of a drug that is not chemically identical to the medication that was prescribed by the physician) except: (a) to an equivalent generic product where allowed by law; (b) in situations where the dispensing pharmacist, in the exercise of his or her professional judgment, believes that the medication prescribed by the physician may be unsafe or otherwise clinically inappropriate for the patient (the medication is then substituted only with the treating physician's consent); or, (c) if directed by CuraScript's client. Certain materials provided by CuraScript to patients may be provided or funded by pharmaceutical manufacturers, in which case, CuraScript complies with applicable law related to such materials.

This Disclosure Statement supersedes previous disclosures and/or statements made by CuraScript in connection with the subject matter hereof.
